MANUFACTURER'S CERTIFICATION STATEMENT

For Residential Energy Efficient Properties purchases

Under Title 26 - Internal Revenue Code § 25D, which covers Residential Energy Efficient Property, the IRS allows for a federal investment Tax Credit (ITC) of up to 30% for the installation of residential energy-efficient systems. A “qualified solar electric property expenditure” refers to costs for property that utilizes solar energy to generate electricity in a qualified dwelling located in the United States, used as a residence by the taxpayer.
